



The Amazing Shake – Scenario Rules & Regulations

Purpose

- The purpose of these Rules & Regulations is to provide a consistent framework for evaluating student performance during the Amazing Shake scenario rounds. These standards ensure fairness, professionalism, and alignment with the program's core values of confidence, poise, and problem-solving under pressure.

Guidelines

- Scenarios will encompass possible awkward or challenging situations that could arise in a workplace or professional setting.
- Students are expected to remain composed under pressure and respond respectfully.
- Each scenario should permit multiple valid solutions, encouraging creativity and adaptability.
- Judges should focus on evaluating the process and delivery, not solely the outcome.

Rules

- All students will be presented with the same scenario during each round.
- Responses must be delivered within the time limit provided.
- Students are required to: - Greet judges confidently. - Maintain eye contact and good posture. - Speak clearly and professionally.
- Disrespectful, dismissive, or inappropriate responses may result in point deductions.
- Judges will use a scoring rubric when assessing students.

Expectations

- Students will demonstrate confidence, courtesy, and professionalism throughout the competition.
- Teachers and judges will model and reinforce the same professional standards expected of students.
- Each scenario is an opportunity for students to practice critical thinking, problem-solving, and communication skills.
- Students should be prepared to adapt their tone and approach depending on the situation presented.
- Consistency, fairness, and encouragement are to be upheld by all facilitators and judges.
